EXCHANGE NOMINATION

Home institution must officially nominate their exchange students for one or two semesters online before students can complete their online application.

Exchange Nomination & Application Dates

Semester 1 (Feb to Jun): 1 Nov (previous year)
Semester 2 (Jul to Nov): 15 Mar (same year)

The details and link to nominate students online will be sent to exchange partners through email.

Compulsory health insurance cover

It is a visa requirement that students have valid Overseas Student Health Cover for the duration of their visa.

La Trobe University has an agreement for OSHC with Medibank Private
