Brock University has committed more than **\$4 MILLION** to our awards programs for 2019-20. Awards offered to international students pursuing undergraduate studies at Brock include:

BROCK SCHOLARS AWARD UP TO \$4,000 PER ACADEMIC YEAR

Students are automatically considered if they meet the following qualifications:

- Achieved an A- admissions average or higher*
- Have no previous post-secondary experience

INTERNATIONAL CURRICULUM AWARD \$1,000

Students are automatically considered if they have achieved an A- admissions average* and one of the following:

- IB diploma successful completion
- AP: incoming first year undergraduate students with three AP courses with an exam score of 3 or more
- A-level final year average of C or higher

EMERGING MARKET ENTRANCE AWARD

UP TO \$4,000 IN THE FIRST YEAR OF STUDY

Students who qualify for the Brock Scholars Award will automatically receive the award if they are citizens of: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Colombia, Costa Rica, Curacao, Ecuador, Egypt, Ethiopia, Kenya, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Turkey, Ukraine or Vietnam.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AMBASSADOR AWARD

UP TO \$20,000**

Awarded annually to a maximum of 15 students who do not hold citizenship, permanent residency or refugee status in Canada. A separate application is required.

International students can easily apply for awards and scholarships via OneApp. Deadline: April 15

**Selected students will receive an award in the amount of the difference between international and domestic rates.

RESIDENCE

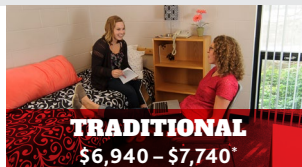
We are happy to guarantee residence to all new incoming full-time undergraduate students, with an academic admission average of 80% or higher (as determined by the Registrar's Office when academic admission is offered), who are coming directly from a Canadian high school where they were full-time students during the 2019-20 academic year; or coming from outside of Canada with no prior post-secondary experience. Also, Brock University must receive both your residence application and residence application fee prior to June 1, 2020. Some conditions apply.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

If your first language is not English, you must prove proficiency with one of the following, or equivalent:

IELTS

Overall 6.5, no band below 6.0

For co-op Accounting, 7.0, with no band below 6.5

TOEFL IBT (destination code: 0895)

Overall 88, with minimum 21 on speaking and 21 on writing. For co-op Accounting, overall 100, minimum 27 on writing and 27 on speaking

CAEL

Overall 70, no other band score under 60

Brock Intensive English Language Program (IELP)

Successful completion of Level 5

brocku.ca/esl-services

Brock English Placement Test (BEPT)

Minimum overall score of 600, with no subtest below 400

International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma

Completion of the diploma where English was the language of instruction

Full-time study where the primary language of instruction and evaluation is English

A minimum of three years, with acceptable grades in English and other humanities/social science secondary school courses

ESL SERVICES

If you don't meet our English language proficiency requirements, consider our **ESL academic programs**.

IELP – Conditional admission

An intensive academic English language program for university-focused students. Graduates will meet the English proficiency requirements for most Brock University undergraduate programs. The option to study one undergraduate course is also available for Fall, Winter and Spring Term entry.

Accelerated Program

If you have an IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent, you may study our last level of the IELP in eight weeks. The program starts in July 2020, just in time for undergraduate studies in September.

Academic Transitions (AcT)

A program offering advanced students the opportunity to complete their ESL studies at the same time as they take a credit course toward their undergraduate degree.

ENG4U Preparation Program

Offered during the summer to allow Grade 11 students to build on the skills required to succeed in the ENG4U Grade 12 English course.

Dates: July 6 – 31, 2020 and Aug. 4 – 28, 2020

Summer English Language Program (SELP)

Benefit from five weeks of quality in-class English language instruction, as you study alongside French-Canadian students from Canada's Explore program. You will also visit local attractions and discover the beauty of the Niagara region through planned educational and recreational activities.
