External enrolment. If you would like to undertake the course either part-time (external) or full-time (external), please complete the External Applicant Addendum and the Memorandum of Understanding between the external associate supervisor of the PhD candidate and the Faculty supervisor at QUT. Provisional PhD enrolment will become effective when the student pays the first semester's tuition and Guild fee and returns the completed enrolment form to QUT.

If students are travelling to Australia to study for less than three months at QUT, then it is possible to obtain a Visitor's Visa. If the on-shore period of study is intended to be greater than three months, students must arrive in Australia on a Student Visa. To obtain a Student Visa, a Confirmation of Enrolment form will be issued to candidates for the length of their proposed stay at QUT, as long as fee payments have been made and all course requirements have been met. If you travel in Australia on a Student Visa you are required to take out Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). Full details of OSHC are at the following website: www.oshcworldcare.com.au.

Where a student attends QUT in Brisbane for longer than 12 weeks per year, the student will be required to pay the appropriate semester full tuition fee before arrival at QUT. The cost of any communication or other expenses incurred offshore is the responsibility of the student.
